HOME-SCHOOL AGREEMENT

THE SCHOOL endeavours to:

- Ensure that your child is valued as a full and equal member of the school community
- Care for your child's welfare, safety and happiness
- Provide your child with full access to the national Curriculum in accordance with his/her abilities and aptitudes
- Ensure that your child has the opportunity to develop his/her full potential, good relationships with others and a sense of responsibility
- Maintain fair but firm discipline throughout the school in accordance with the School's Behaviour Policy which will also include measures to deal with bullying, should the need arise
- Set, mark and monitor homework appropriate to the age and ability of your child in accordance with the School's Homework Policy
- Ensure you have a regular assessment of your child's performance and an annual written report
- Arrange Parents' Open Evenings during which your child's progress will be discussed and current work can be viewed
- Undertake to see you by appointment to discuss concerns which have become apparent to you or the School about your child's work or behaviour, or to investigate any complaints you have about any aspect of the School
- Keep you regularly briefed about the life and work of the School through letters, news sheets and notes about special events
- Be open and welcoming and seek opportunities for you to be involved in the life of the school

AS A PARENT I will use my best endeavours to:

- Ensure that my child attends School regularly, arrives punctually, observes school uniform requirements, is clean and tidy in appearance and is appropriately equipped
- Support the School's policies and guidelines in respect of rules, behaviour and discipline, recognising the vital role of parents in fostering good behavioural attitudes
- Support and encourage my child to undertake tasks set to be done at home and promote other opportunities to learn about and discuss my child's education and progress
- Encourage my child to tell me about his/her life at School, sharing problems and celebrating successes
- Let the school know about any concerns or problems outside school that might affect my child's work or behaviour
- Let the school know on the first day of absence if my child cannot attend school and avoid taking my child on holiday during term time
- Attend Parents' Open Evenings to discuss my child's progress and view his/her current work.
