FLU VACCINE



It's that time of year when the Redbridge Immunisation Team are coming back into our school to offer the children (reception to year 2) the nasal flu vaccine. The flu is an illness caused by the influenza virus and it is common during the winter months. The vaccination programme is designed to protect your child against flu which can be an unpleasant illness.

The Immunisation Team will be at our school on Friday 23rd November helping to protect them from the flu virus in time for the winter, and helping to protect other family members because they are not spreading the influenza virus infection.
