Year One and Year Two children had a special workshop with members of the Drama Centre too this week. They were able to think about peace and how we can learn from what's happened in the past.

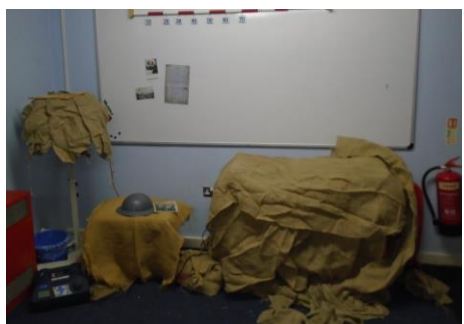


An assembly was also held by Drama Centre staff and the children learned a special song written by Miss Parson. A soldier came to visit and talk about his experience.
