

Reception Routine

Once children have entered school in the morning, they are encouraged to play in their own **base**. There will be plenty of activities for them to explore within this. Once children are settled, staff may use this time to listen to your child read or complete other adult-led activities.

Throughout the morning session, there will be times when children are learning something all together, times when they are working either individually or in small groups with an adult and times when they have a snack together. On some of the days, children will visit the **Computing Suite, Music Room** or have a **PE lesson**. There are also times when they are able to learn outside in our fabulous **outdoor** environment.

At the end of the morning session, children have a whole class session before washing their hands and getting ready for **lunch**. They will then be taken into the hall to eat their lunches and are supervised by many adults. When they have finished their lunch they are able to play in the **Reception playground**.

The afternoon session runs in a similar way to the morning, with a mix of activities available to explore. In addition to this, there will be sessions throughout the week where children can use **'The Hive'**

Children have a **story-time** in their classes before they go home.

It's a very busy time at school so please don't believe them when they say that today they have done 'nothing' at school! It simply isn't true! Please help your child to be able to cope with these busy days by maintaining a suitable bedtime routine, which gives them a decent amount of quality sleep.
