Google Classroom

If you have multiple google accounts, you may need to scroll to the bottom of this screen and select 'Use another account' before signing in with the above details. The password is the same as your child's Bug Club password.

We know that Nursery parents/carers do not have access to Bug Club, and we will be issuing logins to open accounts for Google Classroom next week.
