Sickness and Absences

If your child is unwell and can't attend school, please remember to notify the office by calling or emailing admin.churchfields-inf@redbridge.gov.uk first thing in the morning. After 5 days of absence, evidence of medication, a prescription copy or an appointment card from the doctor is required.

When possible, dental and medical appointments should be made out of school hours, and appointment cards must be obtained. A copy of the letter is required for hospital / medical appointments.
