# **School Times**

Please be prompt and on time – we need to lock the gates swiftly to safeguard our school and also being late impacts on the children's settling and learning.

Reception settling times: 9:15 – 11:30am or 12:45 – 3:00pm until Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> September

9:15am – 3:00pm Friday 17<sup>th</sup> September, all staying for lunch

8:55am – 3:30pm Monday 20<sup>th</sup> September, all full-time

#### Covid-19

If your child develops any one or more of the three official Covid symprtoms, even if they are only mild (a high temperature, a new, continuous cough, a loss or change to sense of smell or taste) they must arrange a PCR test (not just a Lateral Flow Test) as soon as possible. Please follow the <a href="Stay at Home-Guidance">Stay at Home-Guidance</a>. The isolation period includes the day symptoms started (or the day the test was taken if no symptoms), and the next 10 full days.

# Park & Stride



Instead of parking on Churchfields, we are asking parents that drive their children to school to 'Park and Stride' from the Derby Road Car Park (behind Tesco), a five-minute walk from the school.

The council's parking team have agreed FREE parking for our parents to give it a go during the following times:

- Morning drop from 8.15am and 9.15am
- Afternoon collection from 3.00pm to 4.00pm

## **Mobile Phones**

We would like to remind you not to use mobile phones on the school premises when dropping off or collecting children.

There are many reasons for this: firstly, we have a duty to safeguard our children, and the use of mobile devices when children are present, both in our playgrounds and on our school site, is not permitted. Also, we believe that it is really important to talk to your child about their day and their achievements when they are collected from school and as our sign says:

Appointments should be made outside of school hours wherever possible, and proof of these must be given if taken during the school day. The Term Time Absence Request forms need to be completed, and signed in advance by the Headteacher, for all other absences.
