Next Thursday is World Book Day and we will spend the day celebrating our love of reading and books!

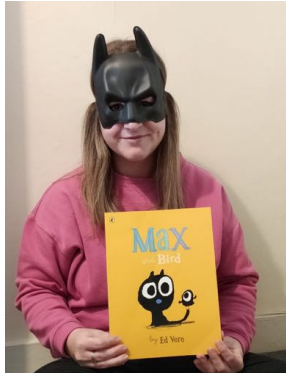
