Nut Policy

We would like to remind parents that our school has a strict '**No Nut Policy**'. We have children in school who have **severe** (airborne) nut allergies.

We ask that you do not give your child any nut products (including chocolate spread) if they have a packed lunch and also ask children to refrain from eating snacks on our premises before and after school. We thank you for your support and understanding in this matter.

Absence in Term Time

We have seen an increase in applications for term absence since the start of term. In line with the Redbridge Attendance Strategy, we strongly advise against disrupting your child's schooling for a holiday during term time.

Our teachers are working hard to ensure that your child is settled, happy and learning in school from the very start of the school year and absences from school during this time will impact greatly on this. Government guidelines say absence during term time should not be granted by the school except in the most exceptional of circumstances. We understand that for many of you, the pandemic meant that you were unable to take holidays and travel abroad to see family but there are 13 weeks during the school year when school is closed and families are able to take a holiday.

It is the responsibility of parents and carers to ensure that their child attends every day. Parents should notify the school as soon as possible when their child has to be unexpectedly absent, for example, sickness. We also ask that medical appointments are booked around the school day where possible, and proof must be shown if they are taken during school hours.

If your child is starting school for the first time, transferring from infant to junior school, or transferring from primary to secondary school in September 2023, you must apply online at www.redbridge.gov.uk/schools/school-admissions/.

Application rounds are now open and must be submitted by 15 January 2023.
