PTA Coffee Morning

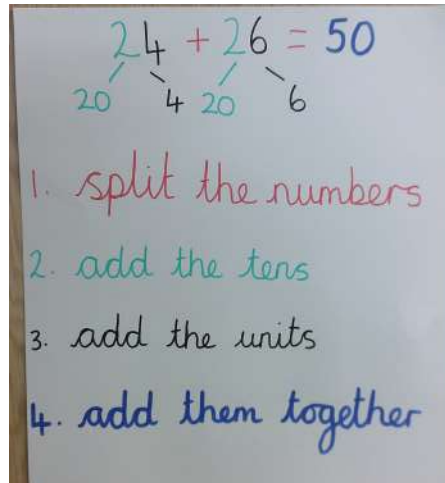
Thank you to everyone who stopped at our coffee morning. It was lovely to see you all and to recruit new members to our wonderful PTA.

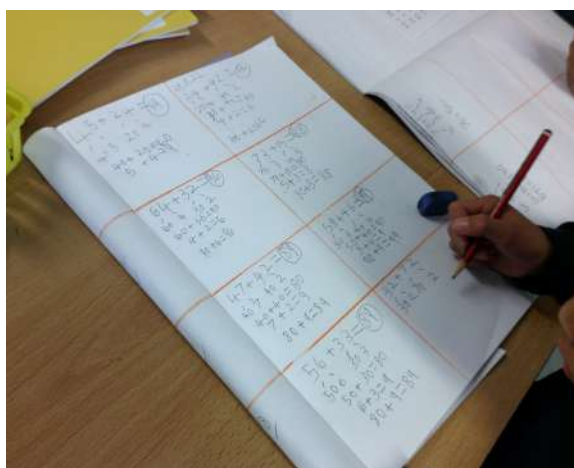
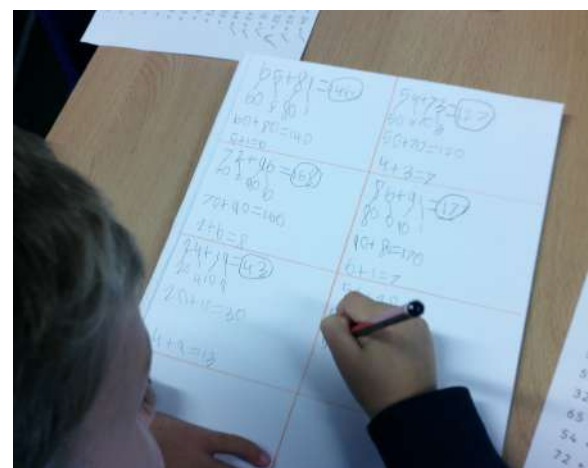

School Admissions 2023

If your child is starting Reception, transferring from infant to junior school, or transferring from primary to secondary school in September 2023, you must apply online at www.redbridge.gov.uk/schools/school-admissions/.

Application rounds are now open and must be submitted by 15 January 2023.

Private Fostering

Are you caring for a child who is not yours? Private fostering is when someone who is not a close relative cares for another person's child under the age of 16 (18 if disabled) for 28 days or more.

A close relative is considered to be an aunt, uncle, grandparent, step parent or siblings. Friends of the family and other family members such as cousins or great aunts are not classed as close relatives for the purposes of Private Fostering, neither are families hosting overseas students who are being educated in the UK.

You need to legally notify us of any private fostering arrangements in Redbridge to ensure the child is safe. Please contact Redbridge Children's Services on [020 8708 3885](tel:02087083885) or email
