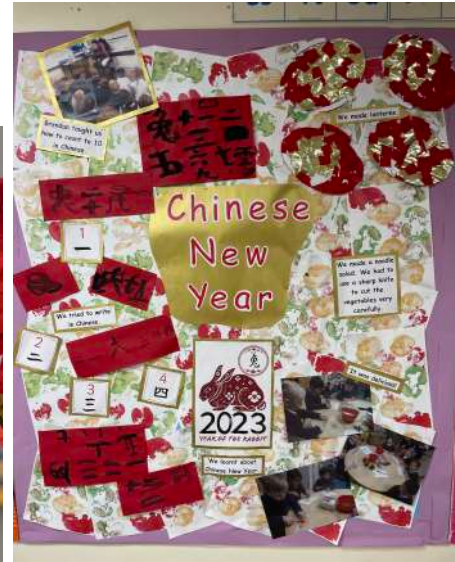

## Science In Nursery

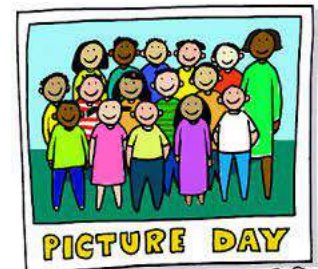
