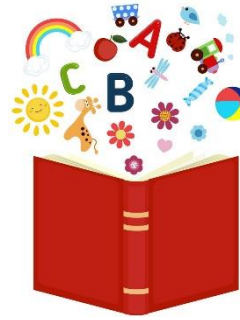

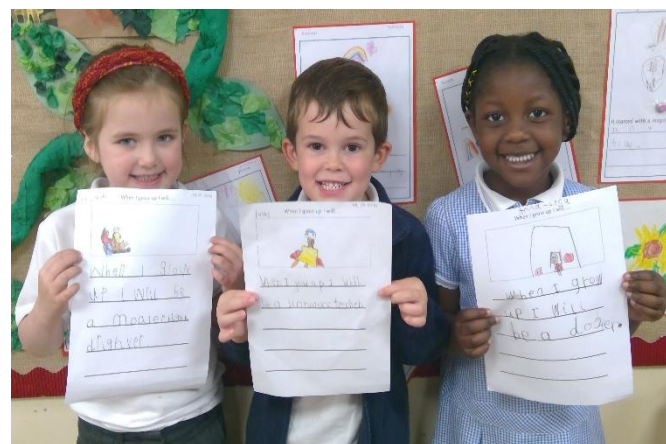
## Lee Valley

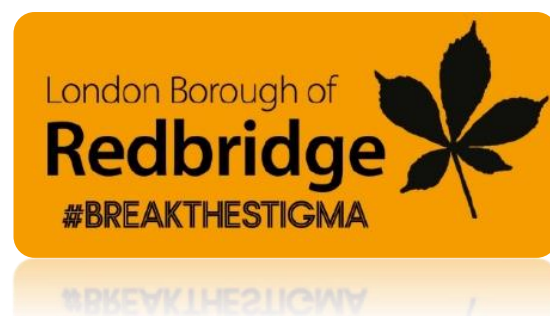
