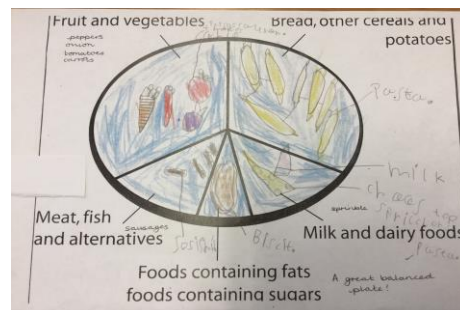
Next week is waste week. The children will be learning about reducing waste, saving energy and looking after our environment.

Please ensure the forms, that were sent out to you, are returned no later than 5th March as the tests are on Friday 6th March.

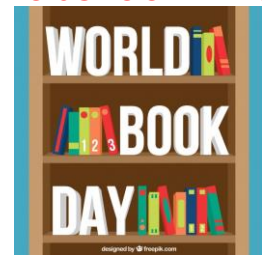
