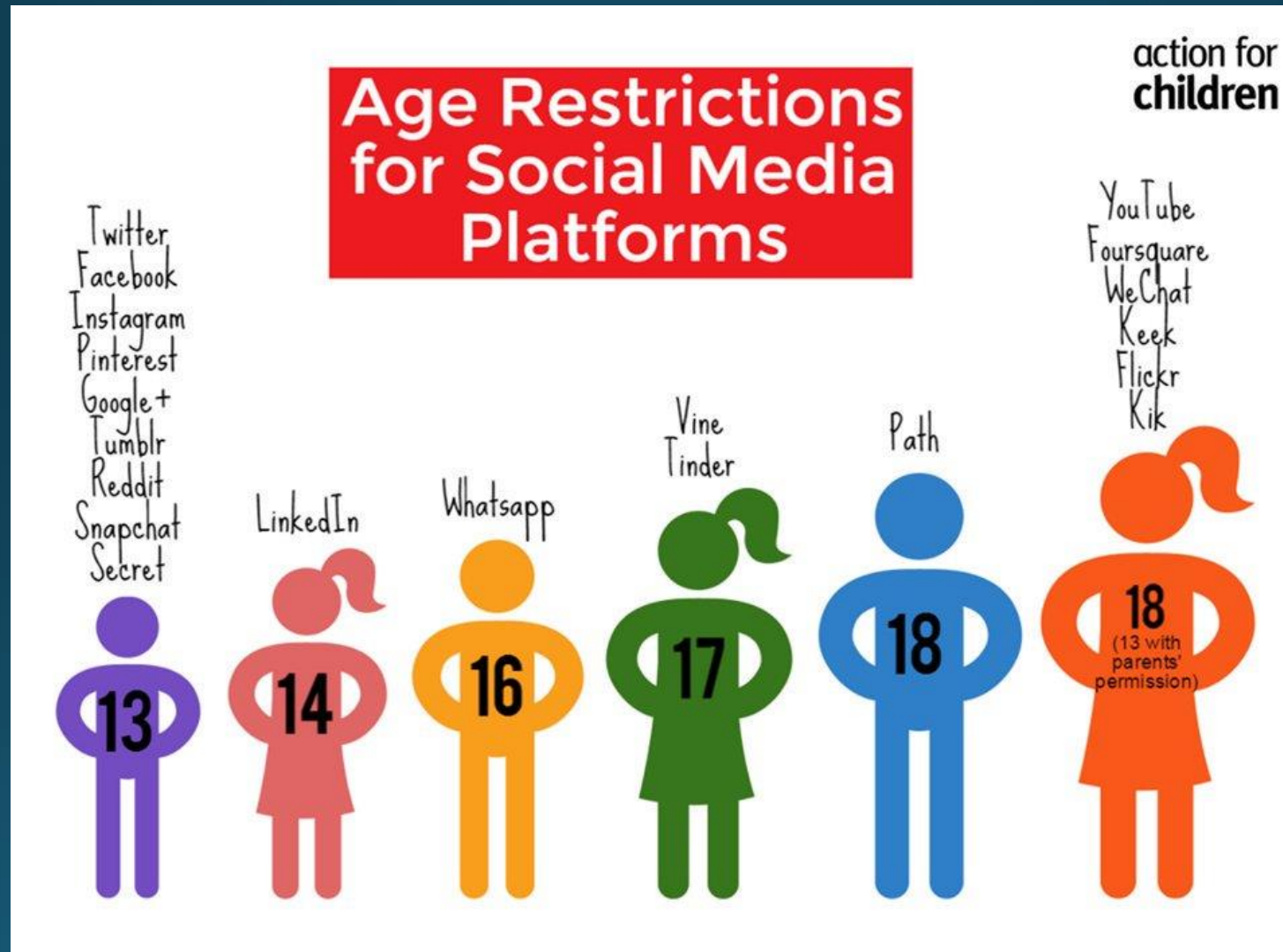
# Social Media is EVERYWHERE
